

Cookie Rules

What are cookies and how do they work?

Cookies are small information files downloaded to your device (computer or mobile phone) from the websites you visit. Cookies pose no threat to devices. When you are visiting a website your internet browser reads the cookie and provides information, for example recognises you as a visitor and adjusts the contents of the website to suit your needs.

What cookies does the UAB NEOCARD use?

Our website uses cookies to help recognise you as a visitor and adjust the contents of the website to suit your needs. We use the following cookies to help improve the functionality of our website and make it easier to use.

Cookie name	Cookie function	Cookie expiry date
<u>_ga</u>	Collects information about the website traffic.	2 years
<u>_gat</u>	Regulates the number of Google requests.	10 minutes
<u>_gid</u>	Used to distinguish users for tracking purposes.	24 hours

How to remove cookies from your device?

The cookies used by the UAB NEOCARD have no personal data and are not used for your identification. However, you can enable certain cookies or delete them altogether in the web browser settings.
